

CROOKED CREEK CAMPGROUND RULES

112 John Deere Lane, Gaines PA 16921

1. This campground is privately owned, Camper(s) and/or Guest(s) accept camping here as a privilege with the understanding the owner has the right to deny access to the property or terminate the privilege at any time.
2. This is a family friendly campground so be mindful of your language. Campers and guests agree to respect the rights and privacy of others.
3. Campers and guests agree that Crooked Creek Campground, its owners, successors and assigns WILL NOT be held liable for ANY damage, loss, injury, "acts of God" or death of person or property of any type.

RESERVATIONS:

1. **All** campers or visitors must check in at the office on arrival, **NO** going directly to site. **Visitor/Fisherman hours are between 08:00AM and 09:00PM. There is a \$5 per person per day fee.**
2. **NO** using the campground / site for any illegal activity or activity which would injure the reputation of the business, all **MUST** follow and comply with all government laws.
3. Camping is an outdoor experience, there will be **NO** refunds or rescheduling due to weather. There will be **NO** refund of any kind if cancelled 7 days prior to stay. See agreement for cancellation fees.
4. All reservations will require a deposit, Final payment is due 15 days prior to your stay. Your reservation is our promise to save you a site for the date and time that you specify, we do however reserve the right to substitute sites. A site is defined as four persons over the age of 12. Additional persons will pay a per person / per night fee. **MUST BE 21 TO BOOK.**

USE OF SITE:

1. Check in 3 p.m., Check out 11 a.m. Any check in or check out outside of these times will have additional fees.
2. Campers/guest are responsible for watching their children at **ALL** times. **There is a 9 p.m curfew for children under 18 unless accompanied by an adult. Quiet hours are between 9 pm and 8 am.**
3. **NO** draining gray water on the ground, septic pumping available.
4. No large parties over 10 persons per site, no loud music or unruly behavior will be allowed.
5. Campfires may **ONLY** be built in the fire ring that is provided, do not move rings or tables provided. **DO NOT** burn garbage, glass, aluminum, wood with nails.

6. NO hunting or shooting of firearms within the campground. NO discharging of fireworks in the campground, this includes smoke bombs, shells and mortars, multiple tube devices, Roman candles, rockets, sparklers, firecrackers, and novelty items such as snakes, airplanes, ground spinners, helicopters, fountains, and party poppers.
7. No more than two vehicles per site. Please park additional vehicles in the overflow lots. You may not use any other site for any other reason without an additional fee.
8. Campfires may only be built in the fire ring provided. Do not move rings or tables provided. DO NOT burn garbage in the fire rings.

SWIMMING:

1. Campers/guest swim at their own risk. All "Waters of Pennsylvania" are jointly owned and governed by the people of the State. By entering the creek, you do so at your own risk. Crooked Creek Campground assumes no liability for your actions in, on, or near the creek banks. Be aware the creek level rises and falls depending on rainfall.

PETS/WILDLIFE:

1. Pets must be supervised. All pets must be kept inside the Camping Unit or on a leash or in a kennel whether on or off the Campsite. Excessive barking or failure of the Camper to keep their pet leashed when outside the Camping Unit, or leaving the pet unattended will give Campground cause to require the pet to be removed from the Campground. Camper must clean-up after their pets, there will be a \$50 fee if you do not clean up after your pet. No pets are allowed around the swimming and other common areas, in or around Rental Units, Bathhouses, Laundry Room, Store/Office, Playgrounds, Activity Areas and Pavilions. Aggressive pets will NOT be tolerated
2. NO baiting or feeding wildlife. To help prevent attracting wildlife do not leave food out , don't leave garbage outside. Dumpsters are provided.
